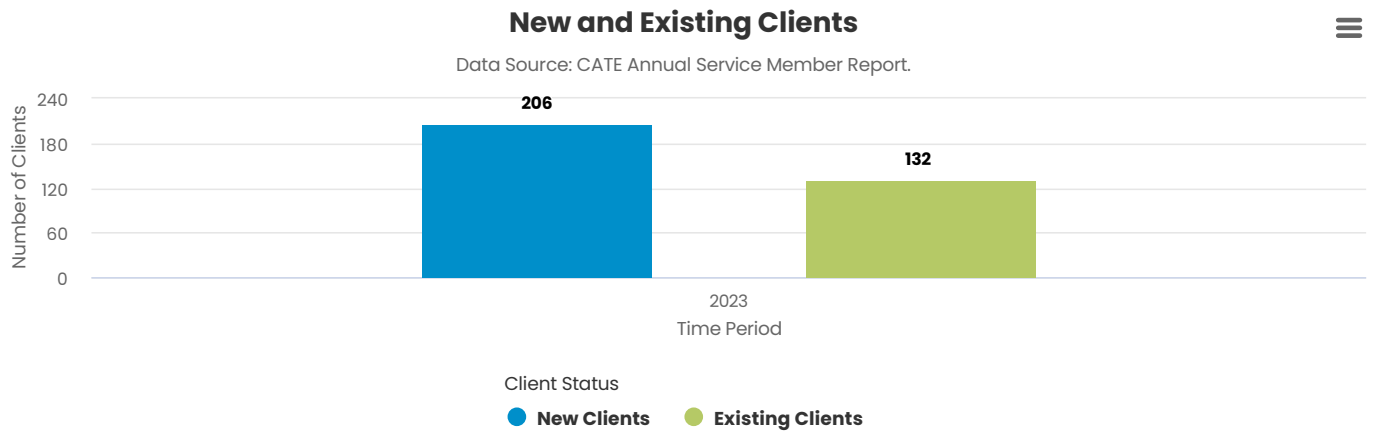

New and Existing Clients

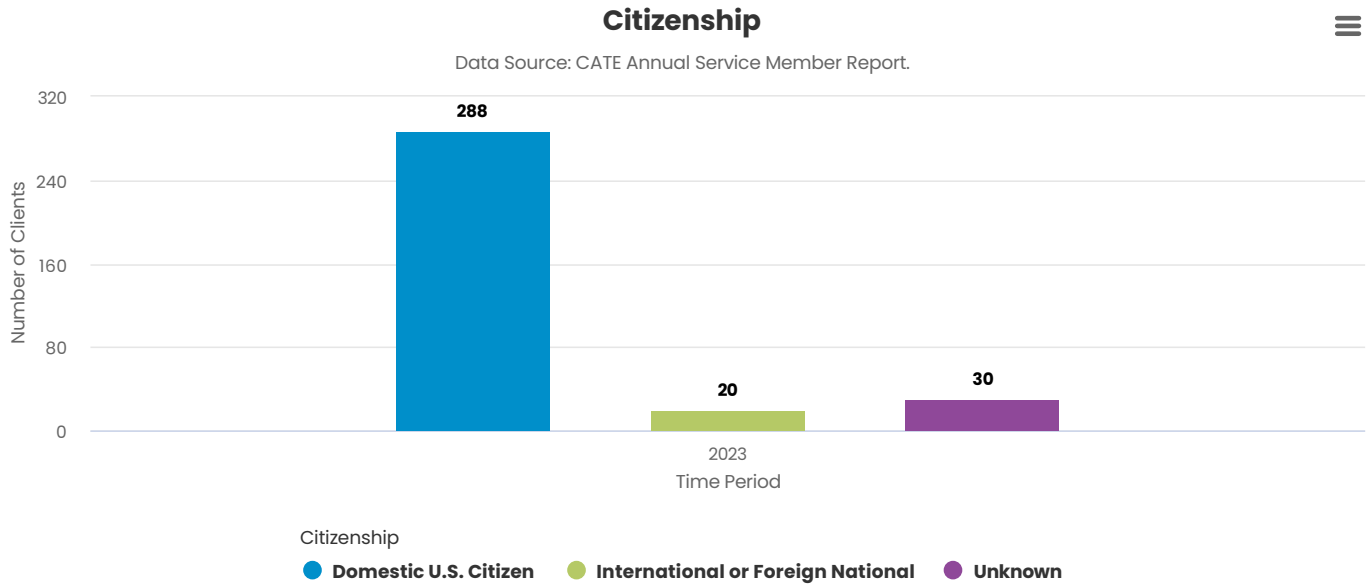
This represents the number of new and existing clients reported in the reporting period.

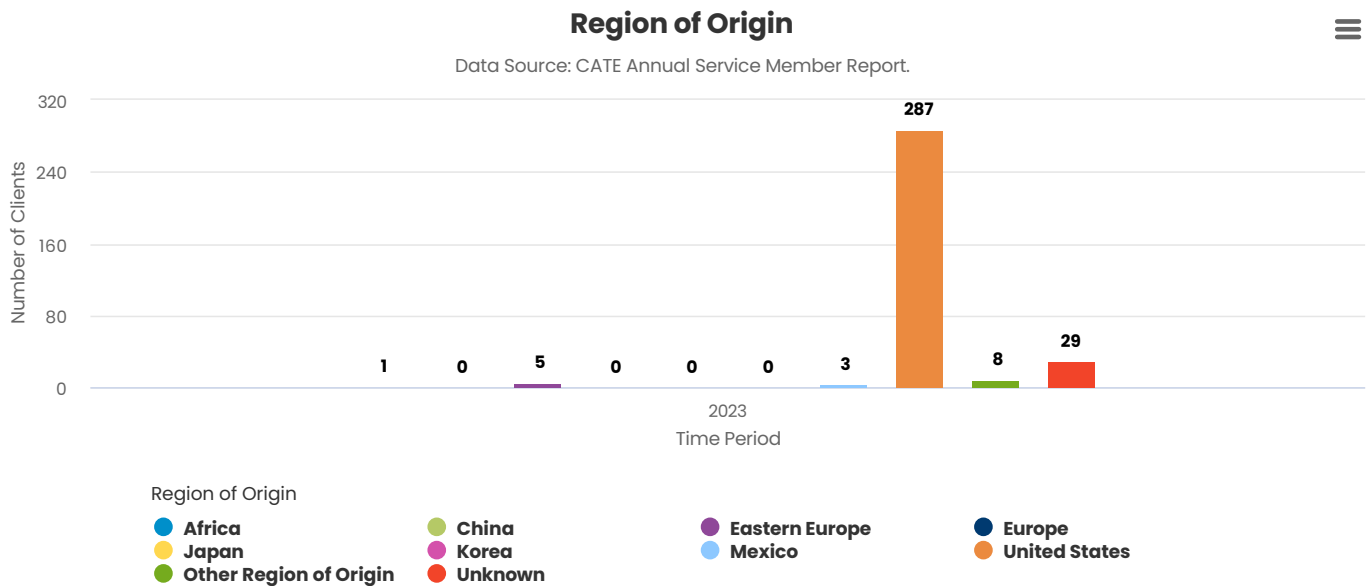
Citizenship

This represents the number of clients by citizenship.



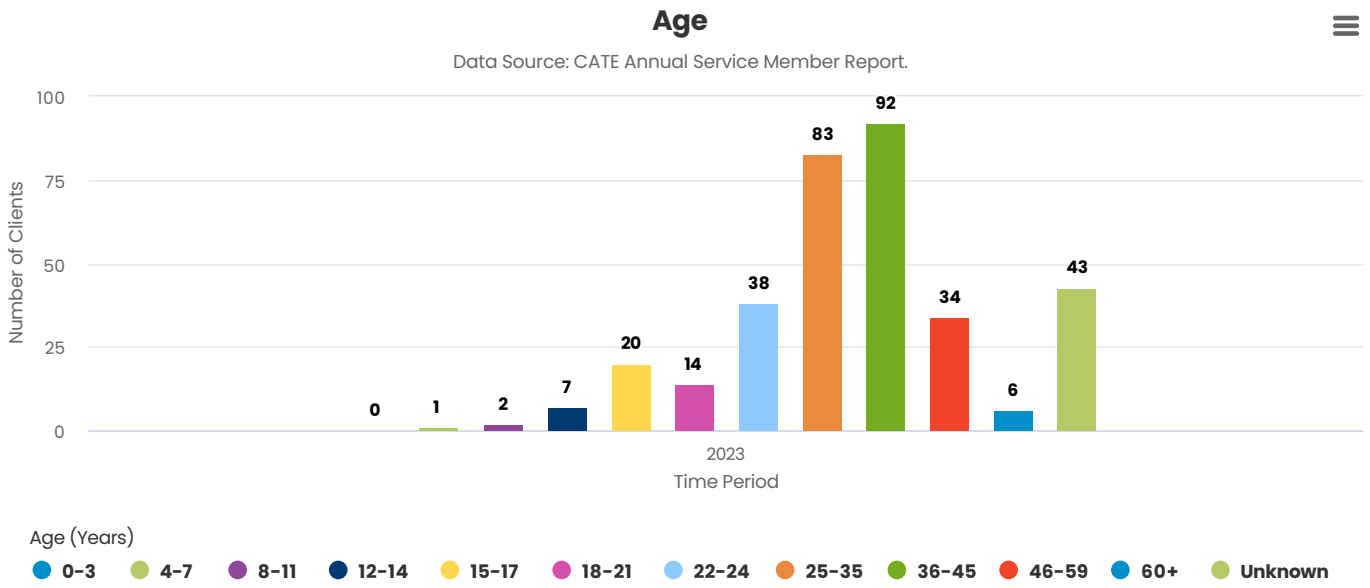
Region of Origin

This represents the number of clients by region of origin.



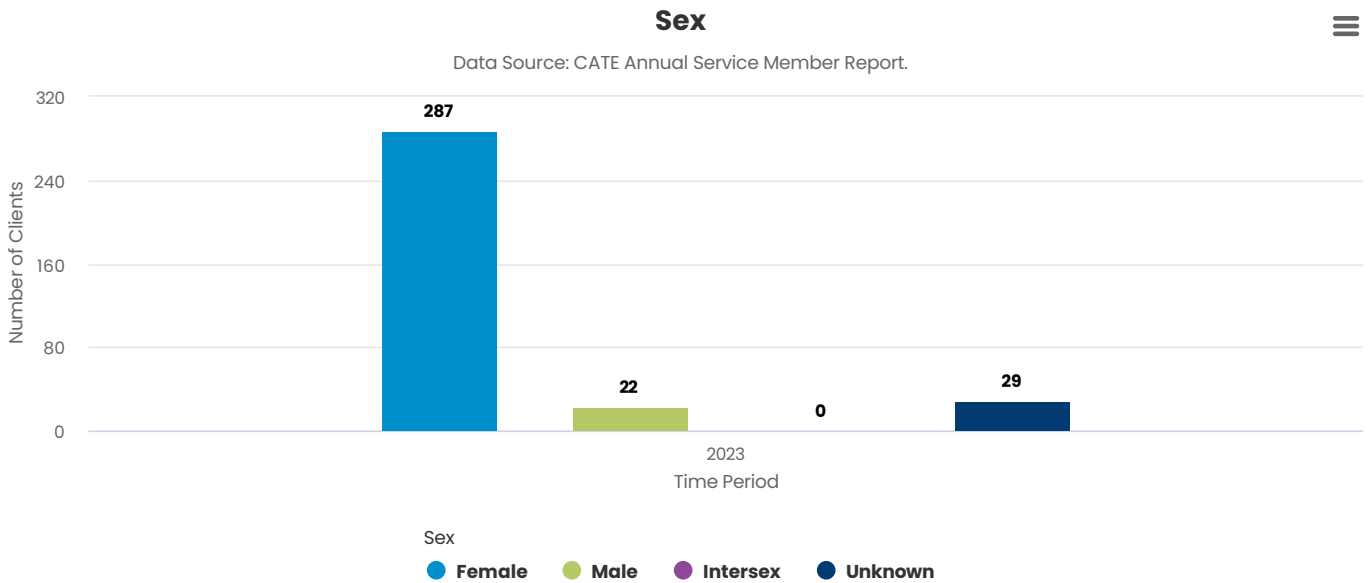
Age

This represents the number of clients by age.



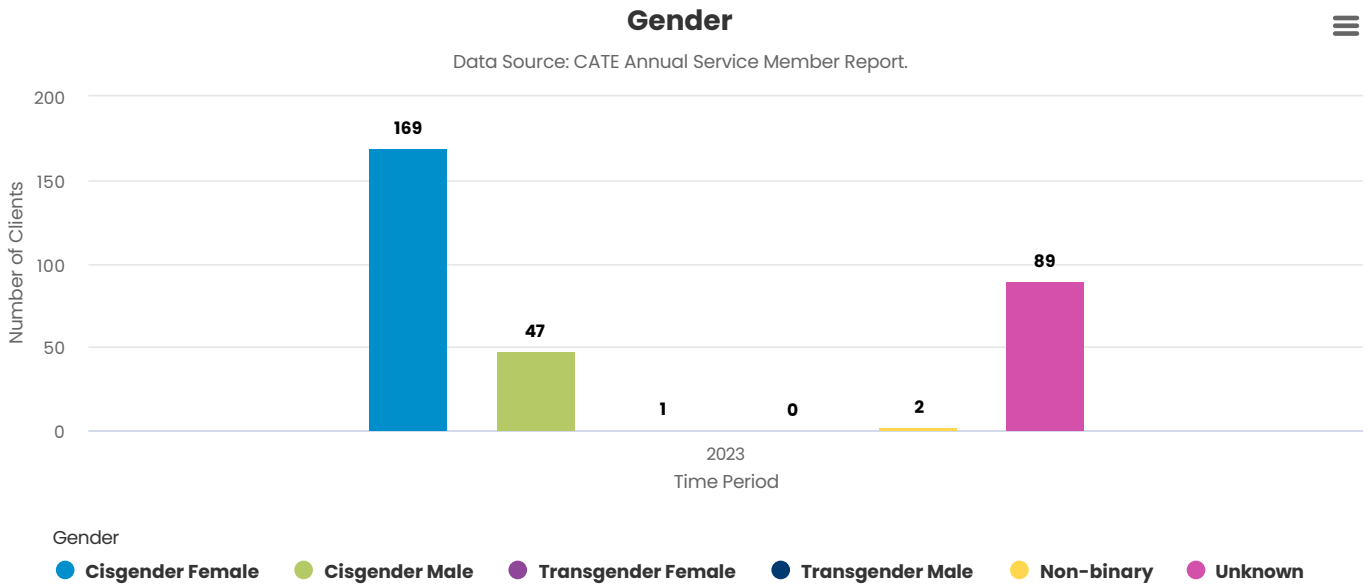
Sex

This represents the number of clients by sex.



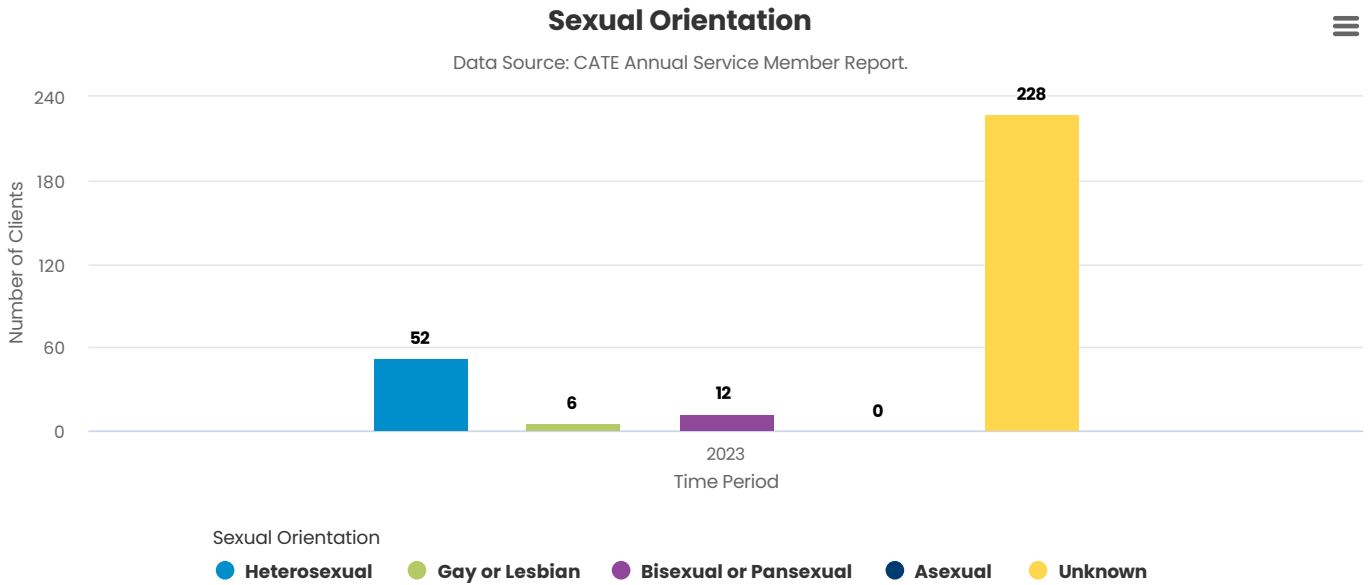
Gender

This represents the number of clients by gender.



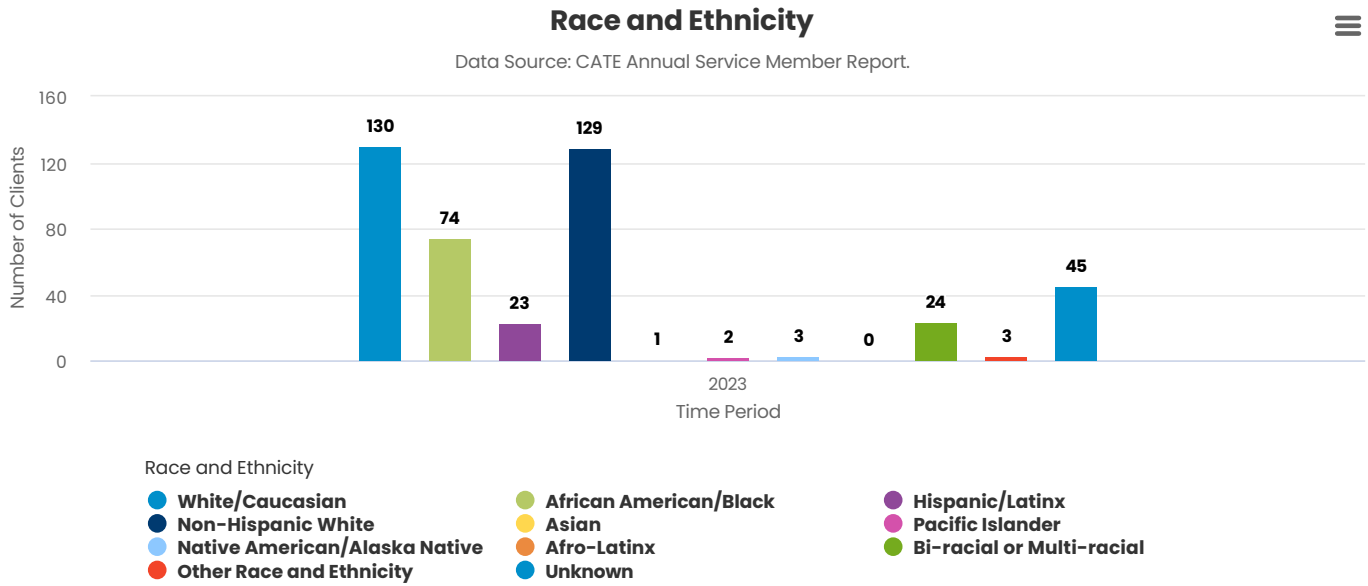
Sexual Orientation

This represents the number of clients by sexual orientation.



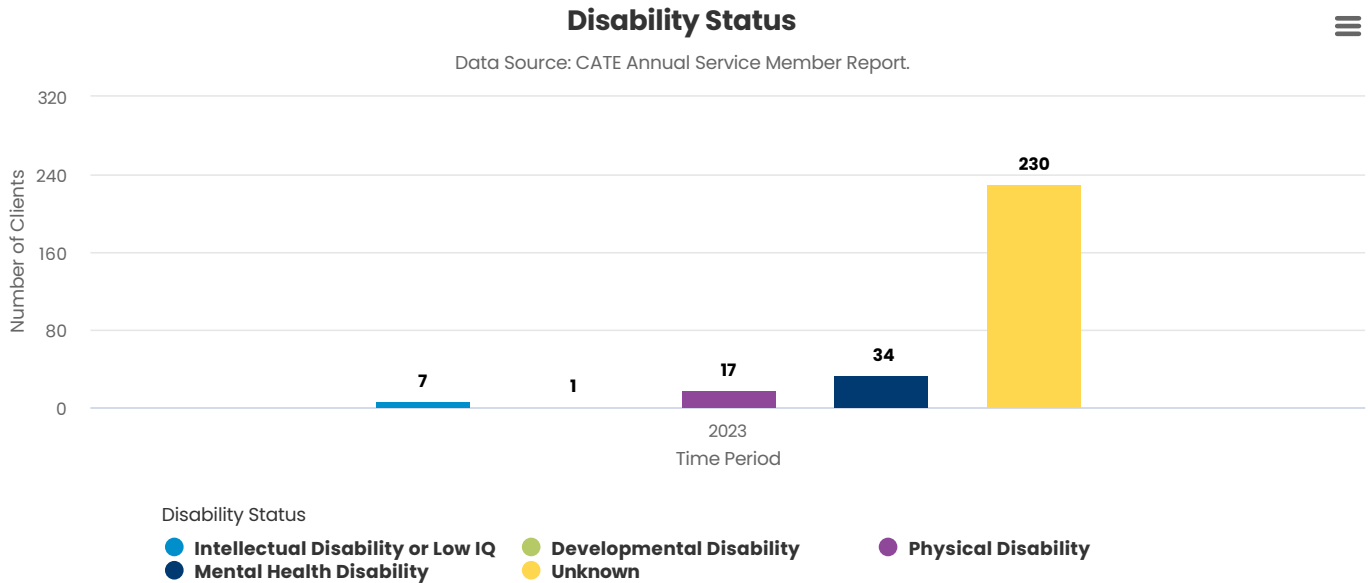
Race and Ethnicity

This represents the number of clients by race and ethnicity.



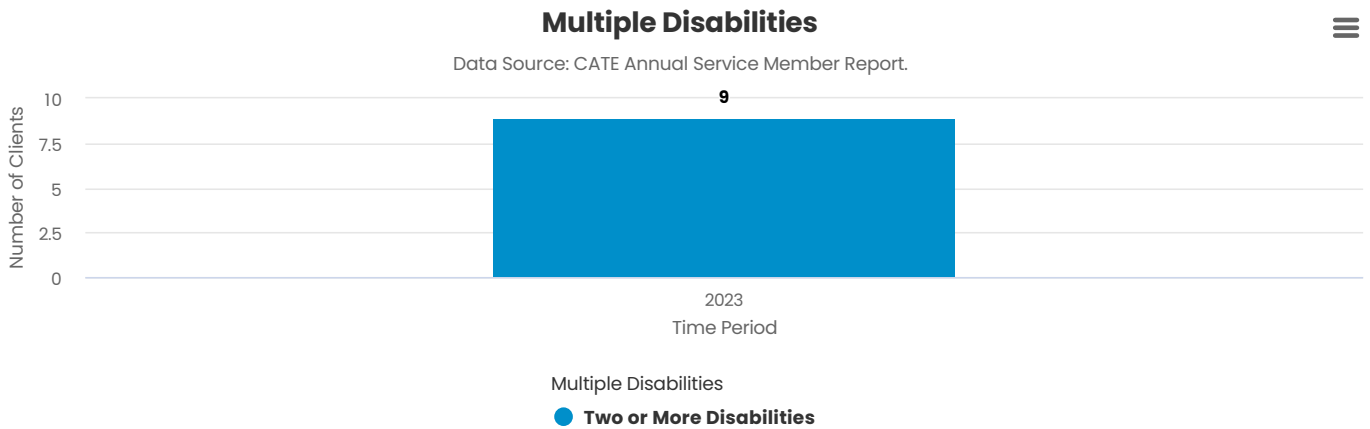
Disability Status

This represents the number of clients by disability status. Clients may be counted under more than one disability.



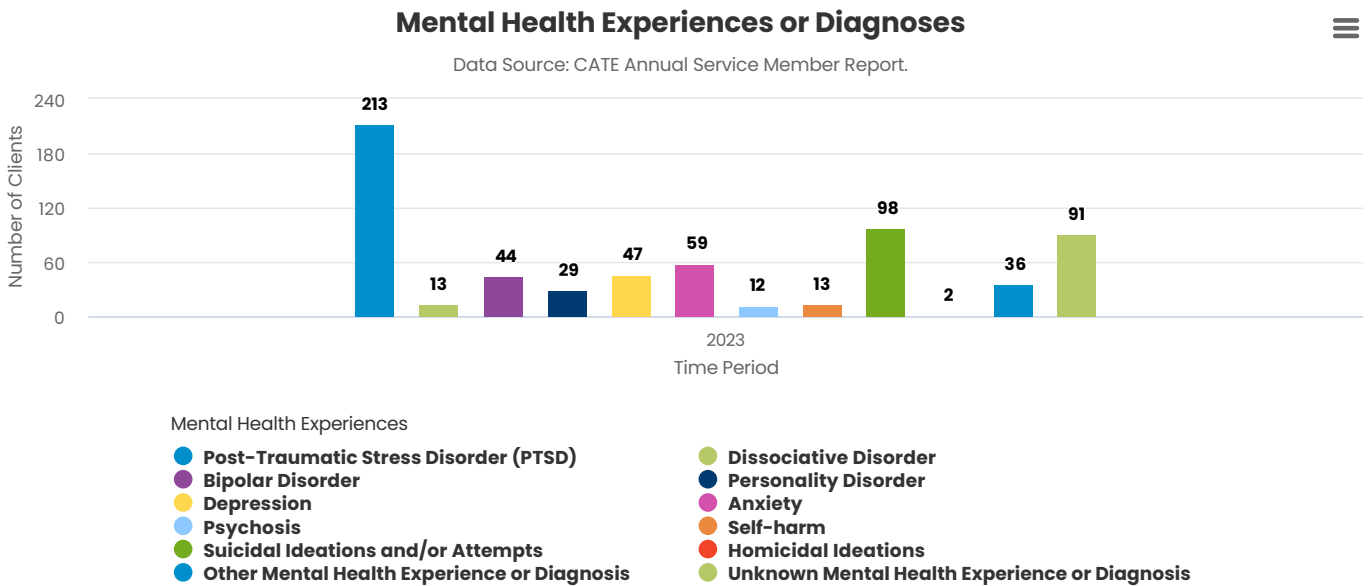
Multiple Disabilities

This represents the number of clients experiencing multiple disabilities.



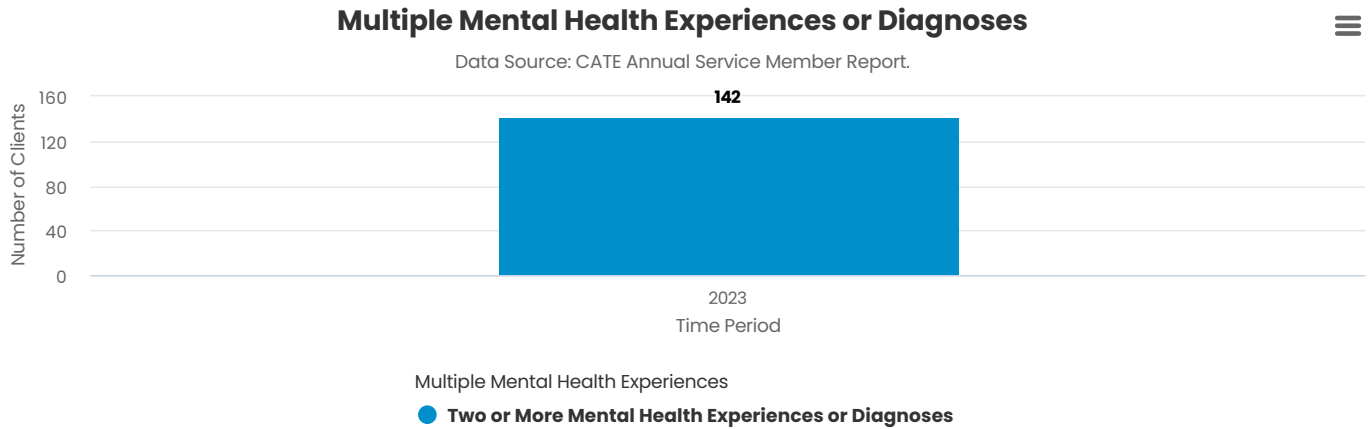
Mental Health Experiences or Diagnoses

This represents the number of clients by mental health experiences or diagnoses. Clients may be counted under more than one experience or diagnosis.



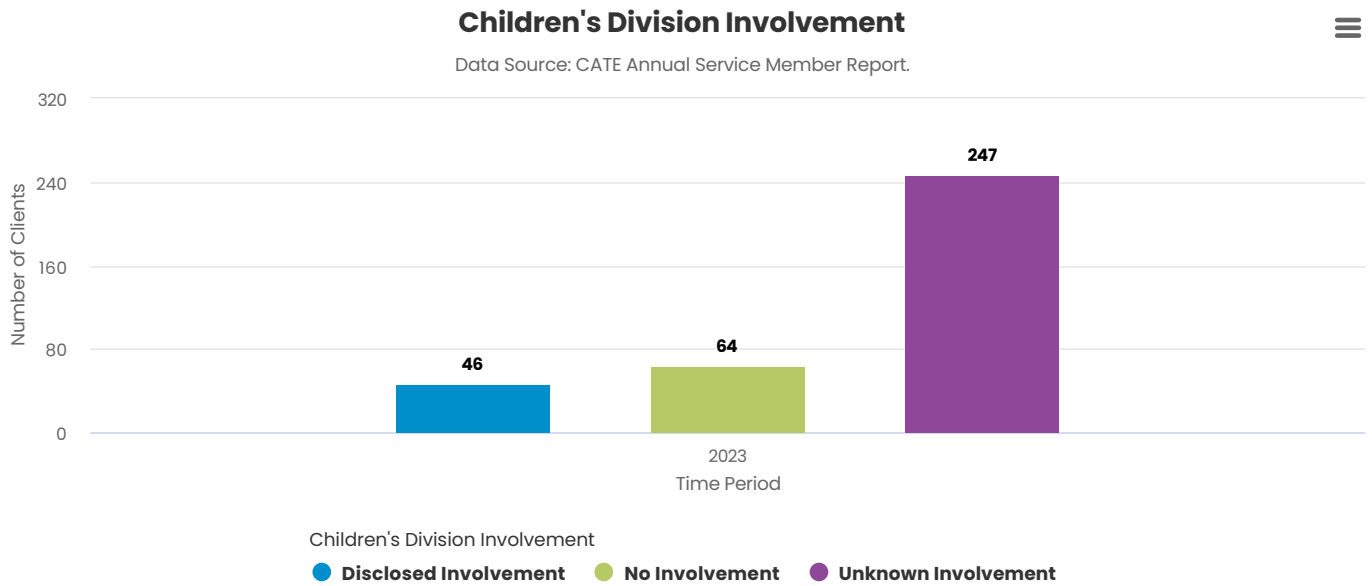
Multiple Mental Health Experiences or Diagnoses

This represents the number of clients with multiple mental health experiences.



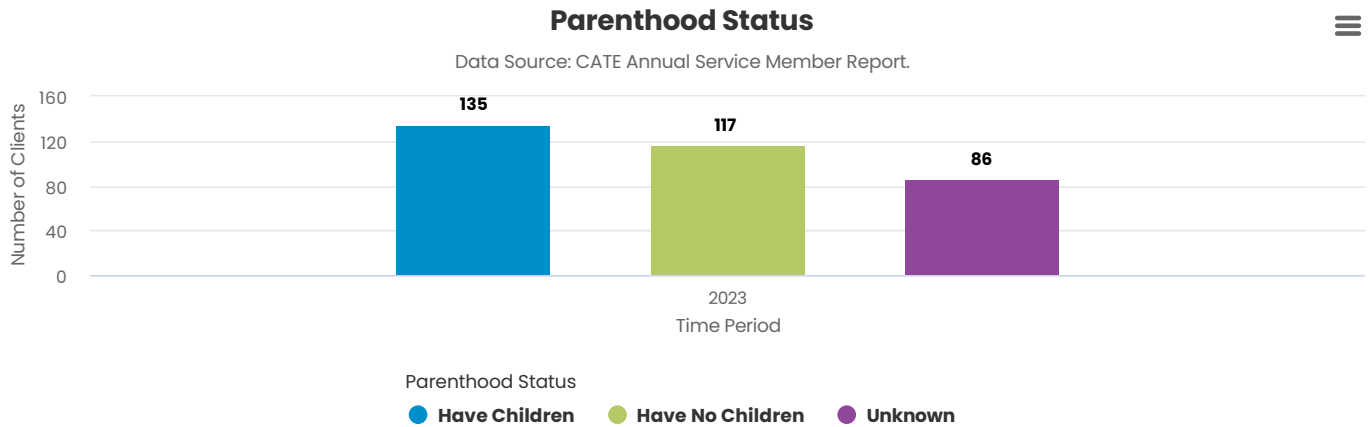
Children's Division Involvement

This represents the number of clients who were involved with Children's Division while they were children themselves.



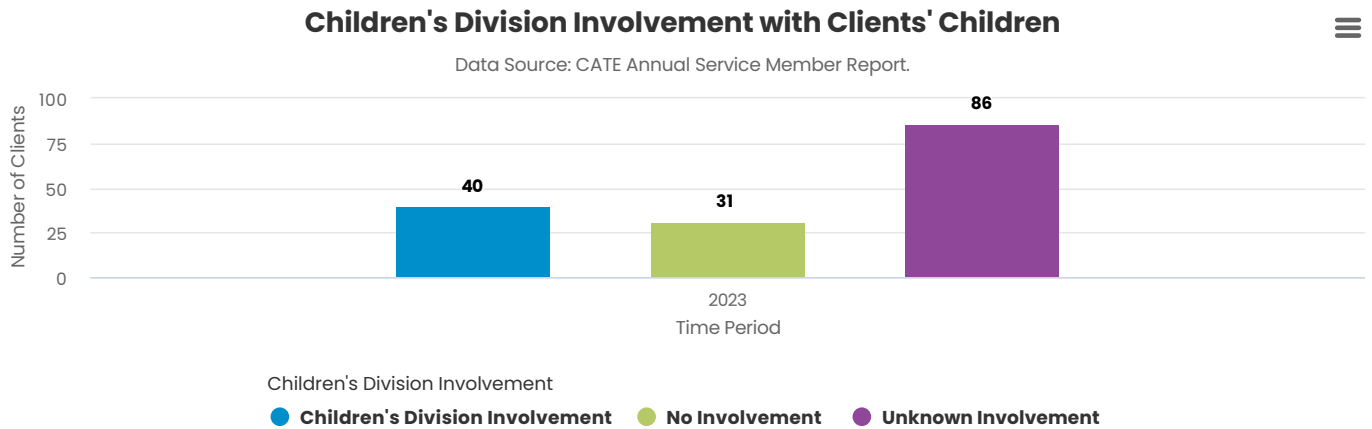
Parenthood Status

This represents the number of clients who do and do not have children.



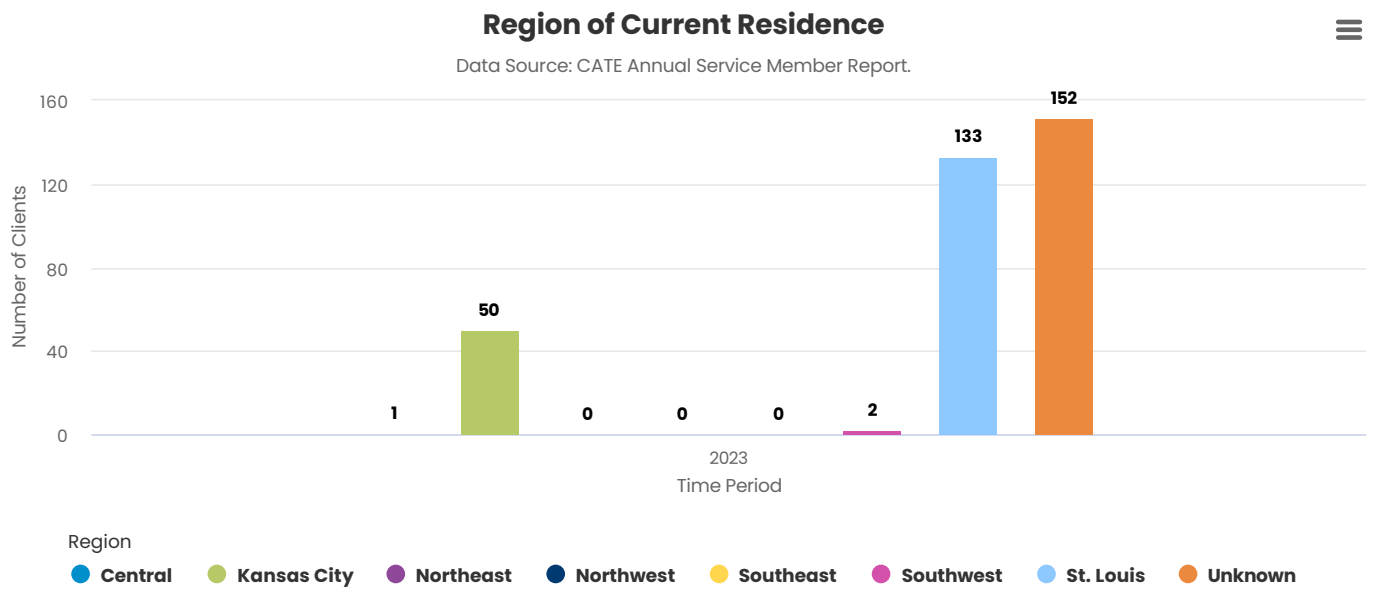
Children's Division Involvement with Clients' Children

This represents the number of clients for whom Children's Division has been involved with their children's care.



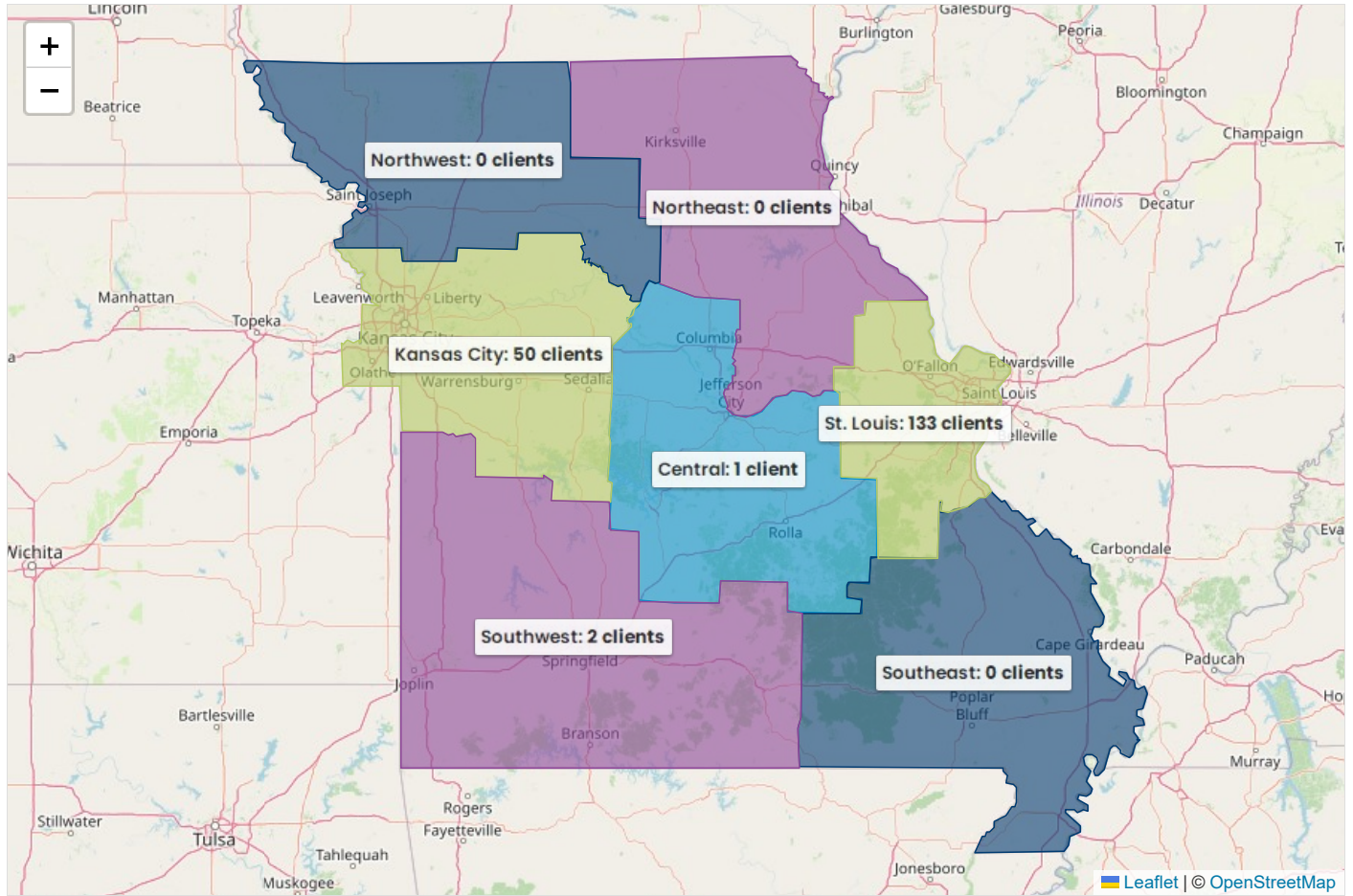
Region of Current Residence

This displays the number of clients residing in each region during the reporting period.



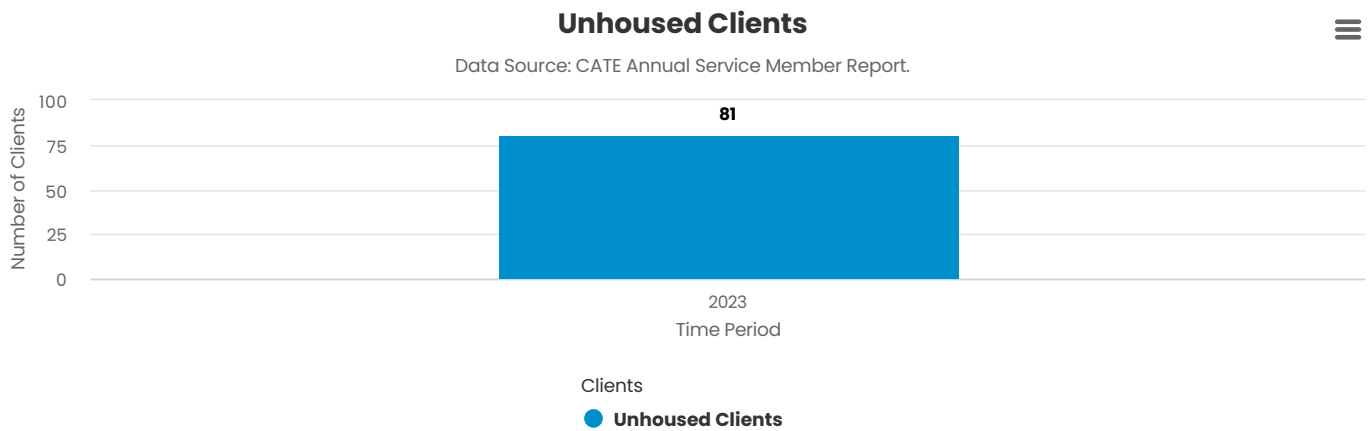
Region of Current Residence Map

Unhoused Clients

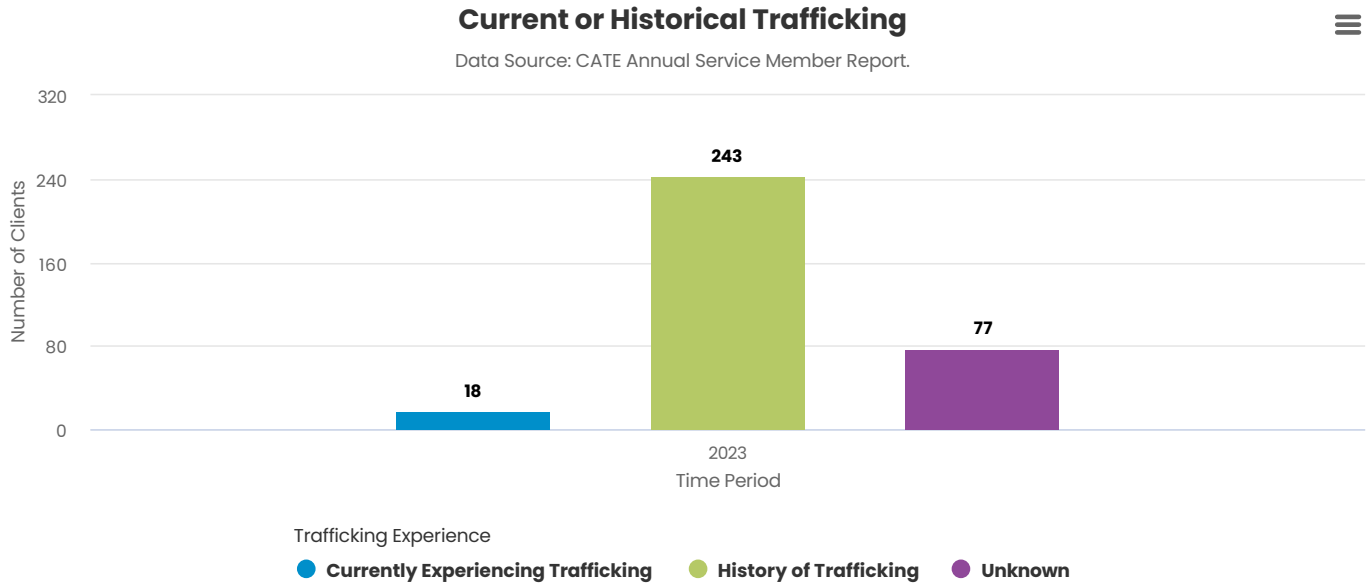
This represents the number of clients reported in the reporting period as being unhoused at the time of intake.



Trafficking Experiences

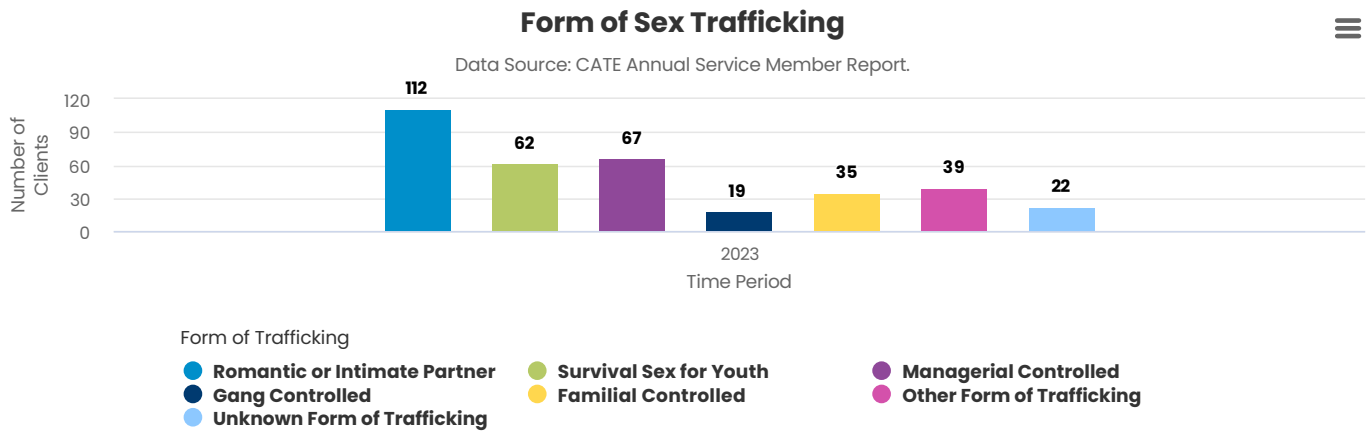
Current or Historical Trafficking

This represents the number of clients by current or historical trafficking experiences. Clients who are currently in a trafficking situation or leave a trafficking situation are considered "currently experiencing trafficking." Clients who are not currently in a trafficking situation, but have been in the past, are counted as having a "history of trafficking."



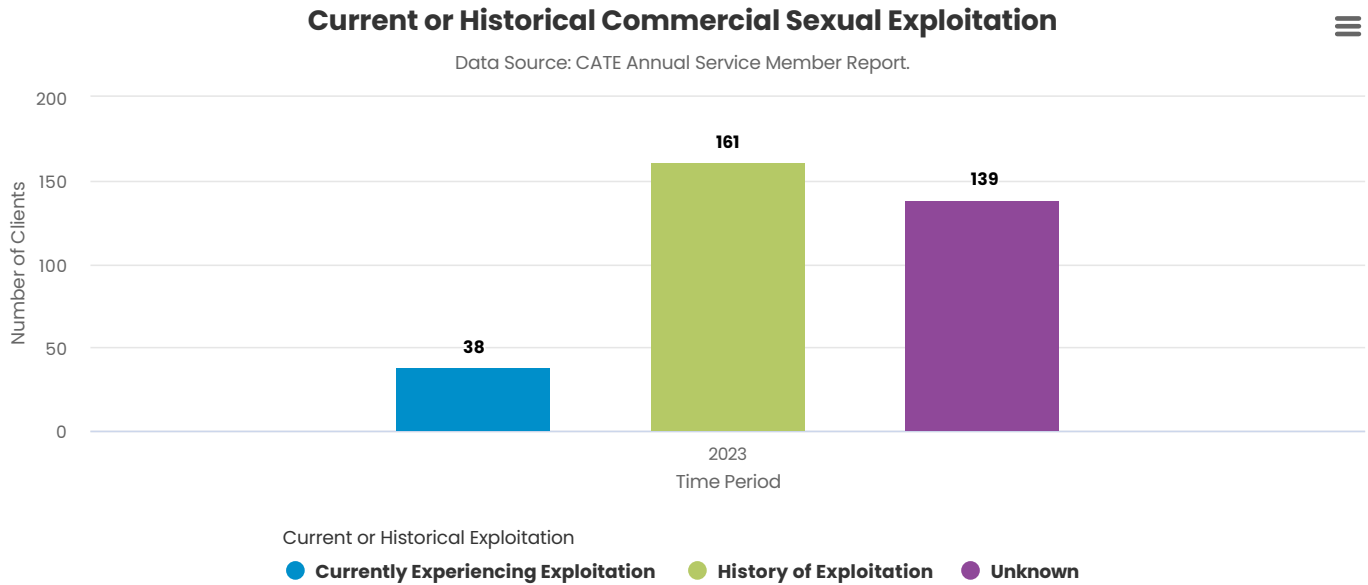
Form of Sex Trafficking

This represents the number of clients by form of trafficking experienced. Clients may be counted under multiple forms of trafficking.



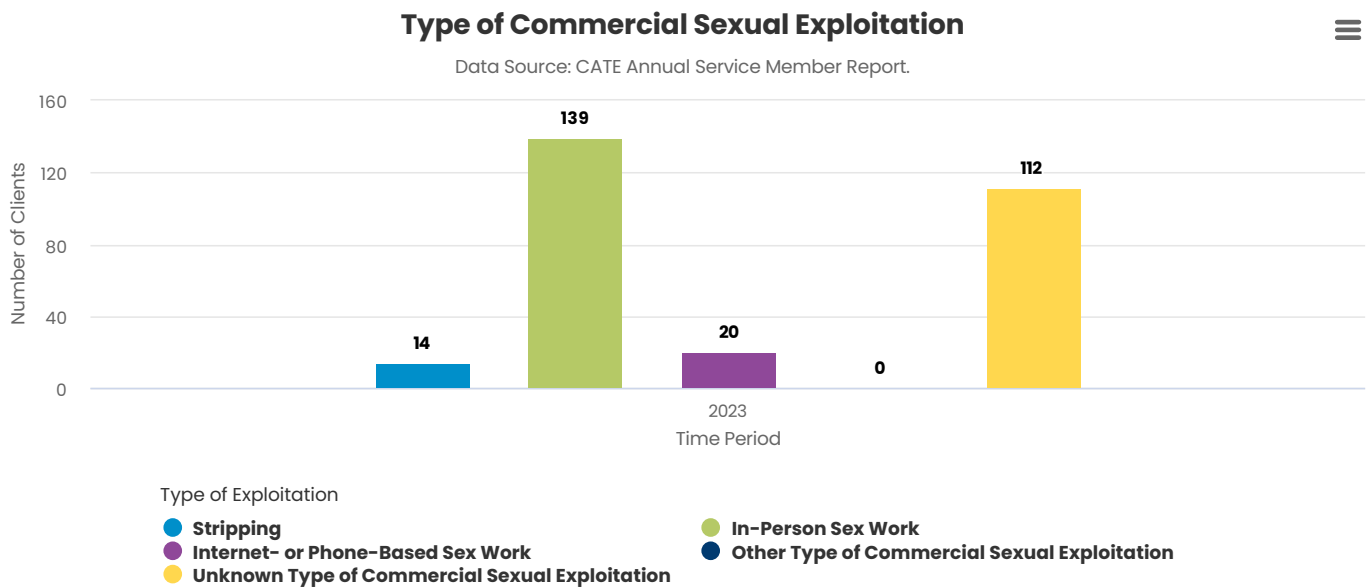
Current or Historical Commercial Sexual Exploitation

This represents the number of clients who are currently experiencing or have experienced commercial sexual exploitation. Exploitative experiences are defined as activities that are used to benefit commercially from another individual through unethical means. Clients who are currently experiencing commercial sexual exploitation or leave a exploitative situation to access services are considered "currently experiencing exploitation." Clients who are not currently being exploited, but have been in the past, are counted as having a "history of exploitation."



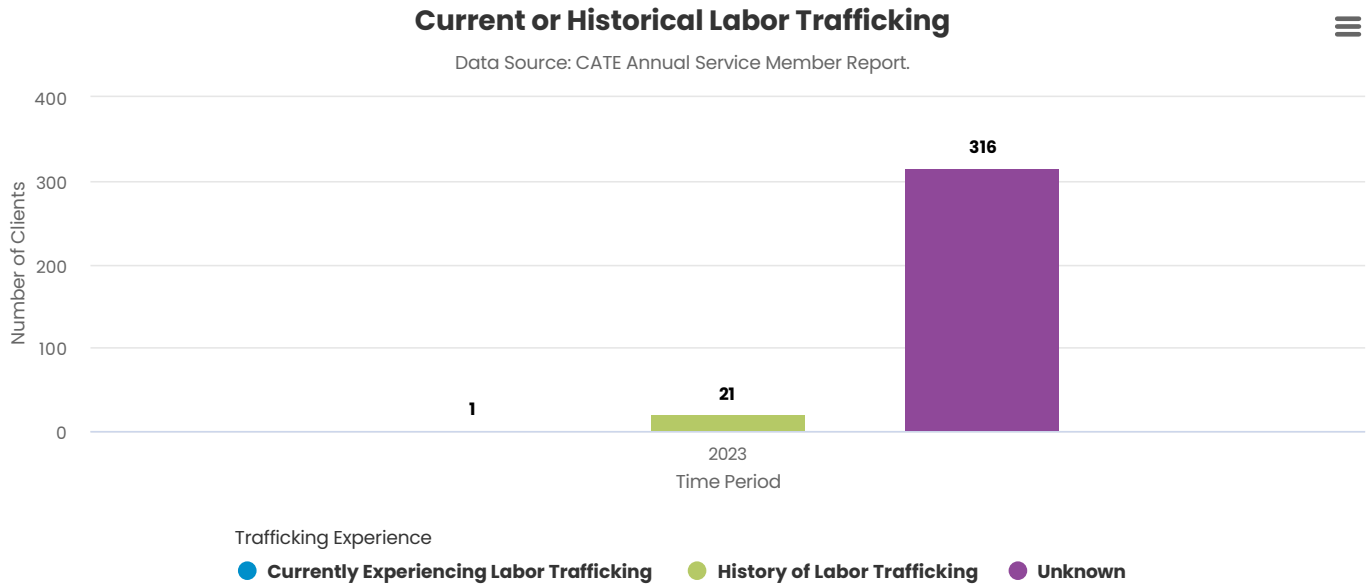
Type of Commercial Sexual Exploitation

This represents the number of clients by type of commercial sexual exploitation experienced. Clients may be counted under multiple types of exploitation.



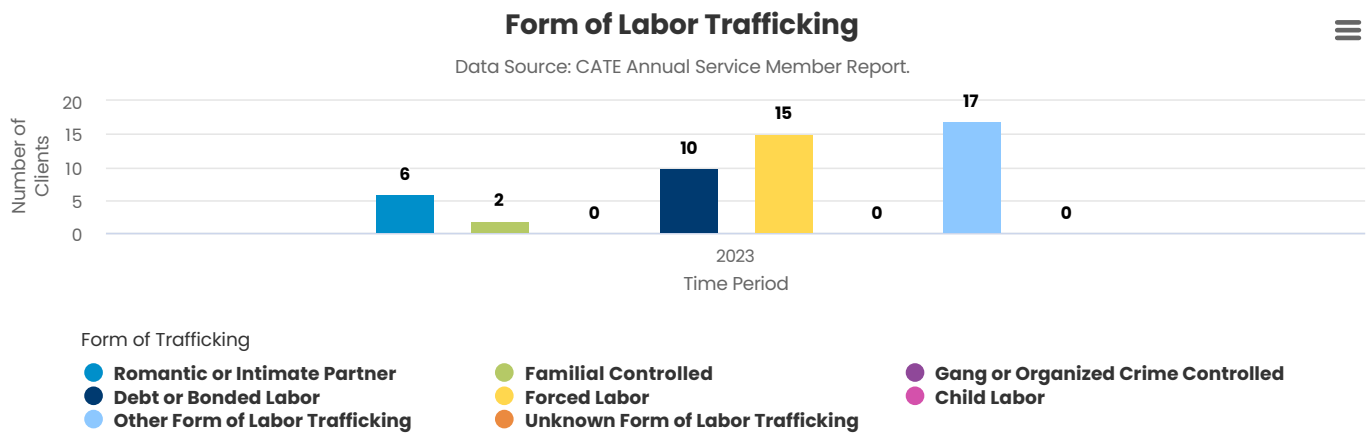
Current or Historical Labor Trafficking

This represents the number of clients by current or historical labor trafficking experiences. Clients who are currently in a labor trafficking situation or leave a trafficking situation are considered "currently experiencing labor trafficking." Clients who are not currently in a labor trafficking situation, but have been in the past, are counted as having a "history of labor trafficking."

This represents the number of clients by form of labor trafficking experienced. Clients may be counted under multiple forms of labor trafficking.

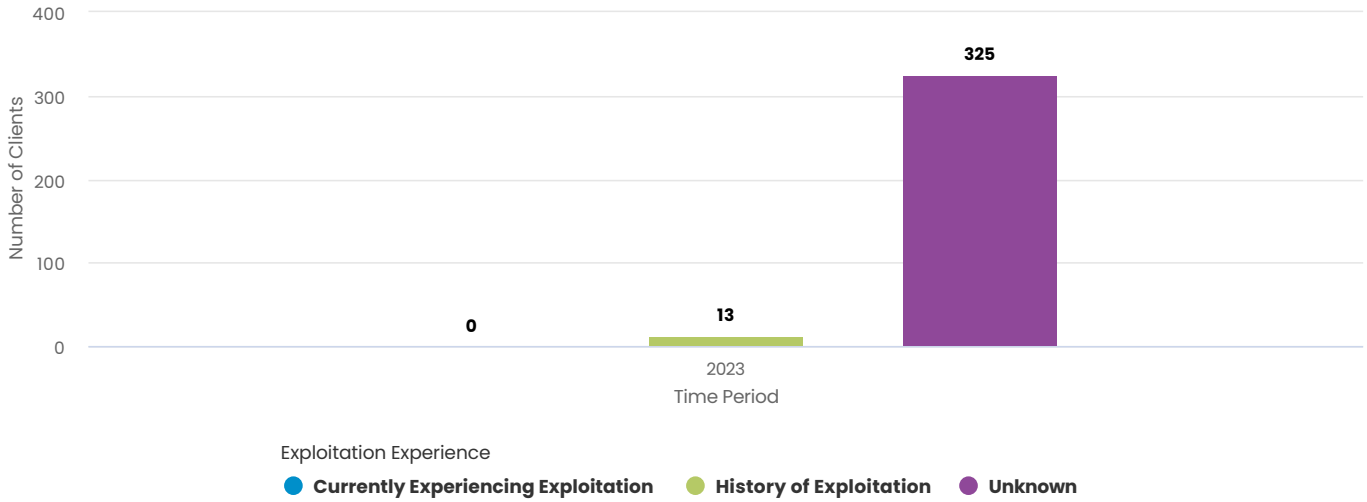


Current or Historical Labor Exploitation

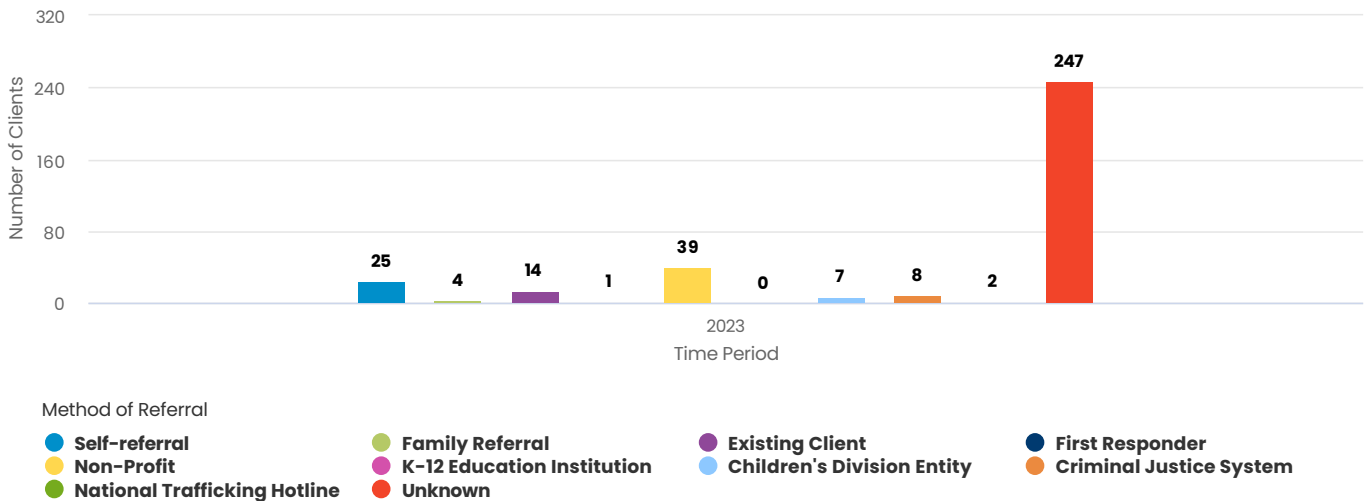


Method of Referral

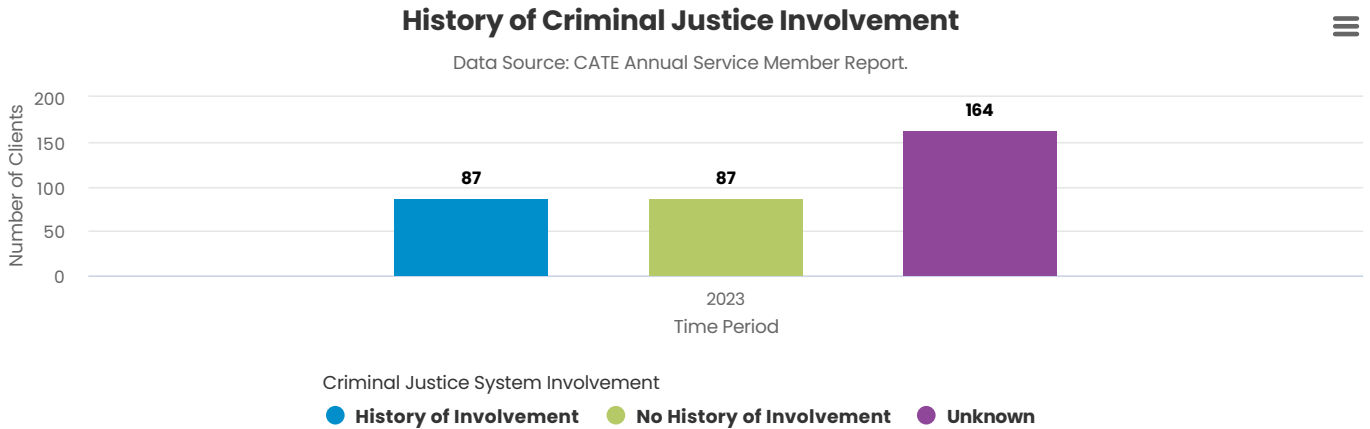

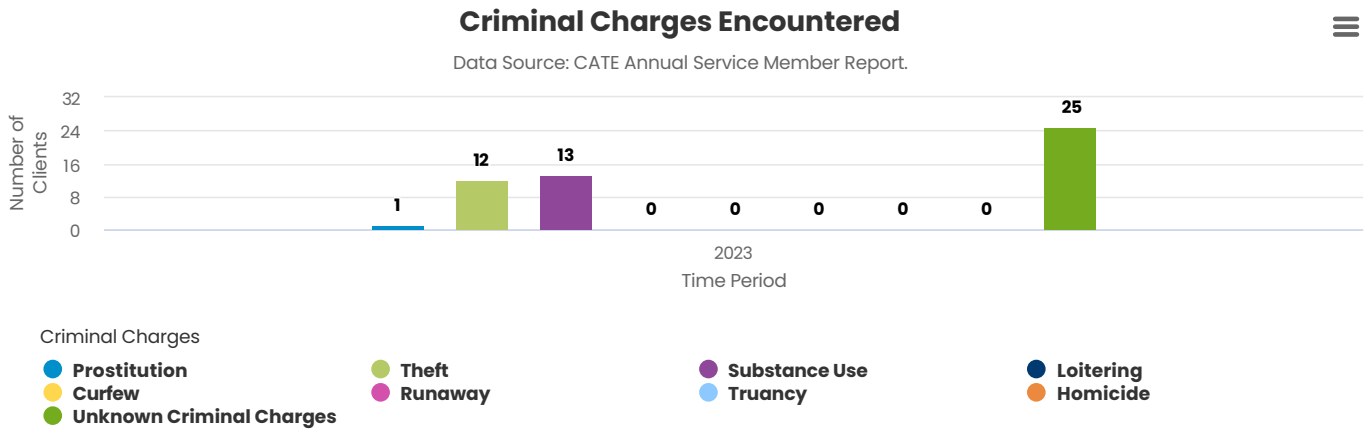
History of Criminal Justice Involvement

This represents the number of clients who have a history of involvement with the criminal justice system. This includes any history of arrests, charges, or prosecutions.



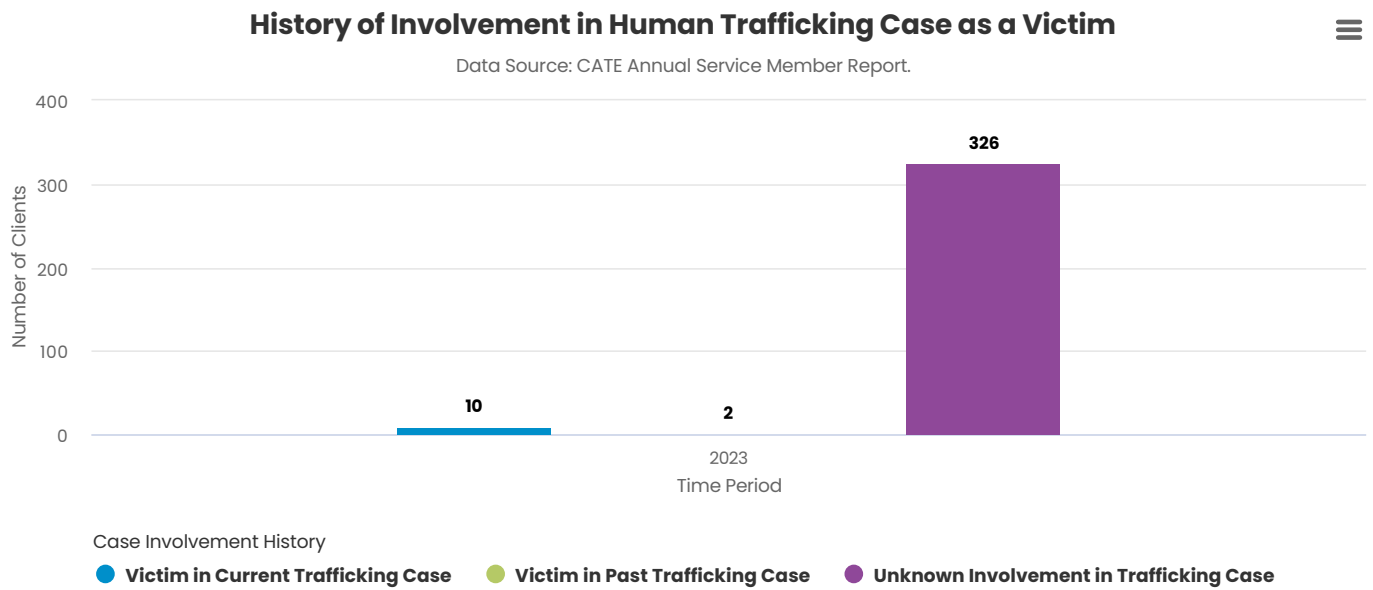
Criminal Charges Encountered

History of Involvement in Human Trafficking Case as a Victim

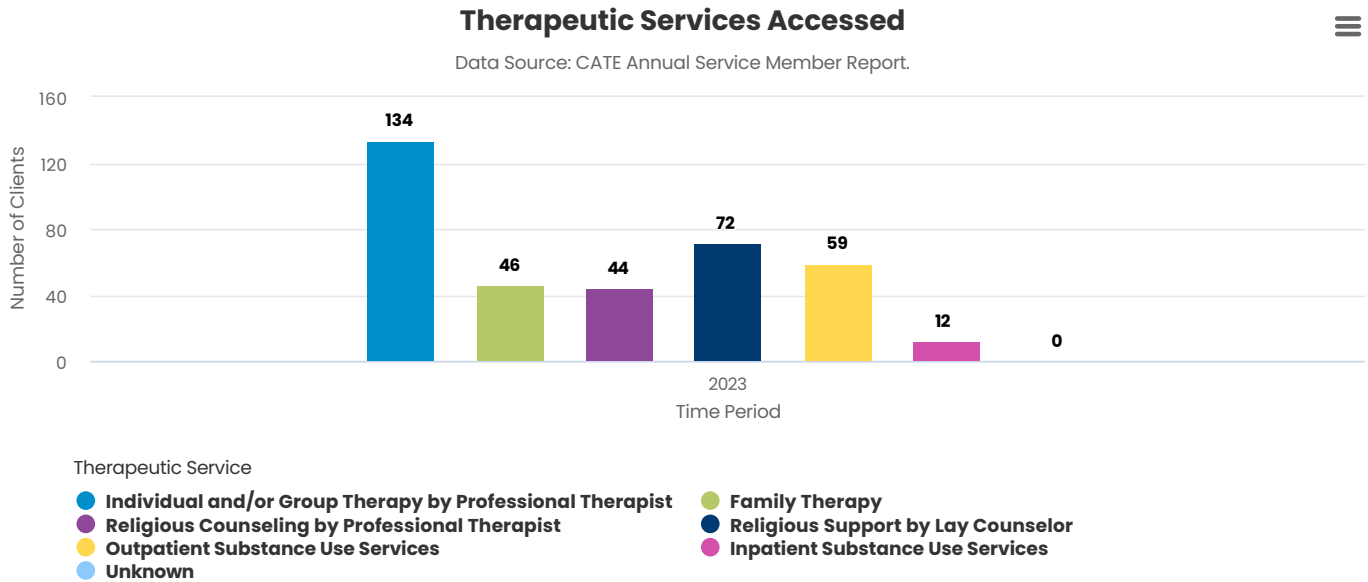
This represents the number of clients who are or have been involved in a human trafficking case as a victim.



Services Accessed

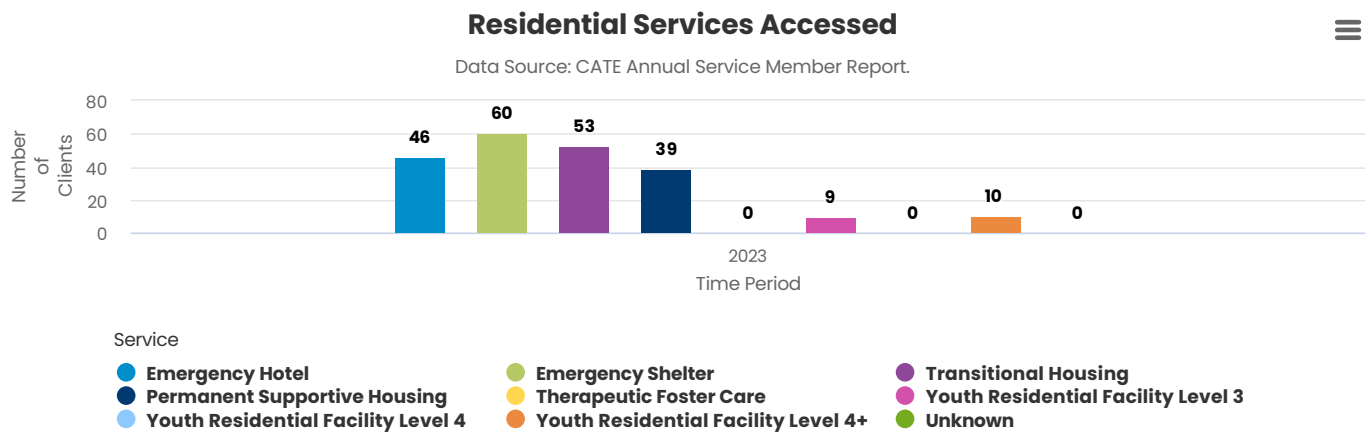
Therapeutic Services Accessed

This represents the number of clients accessing each therapeutic service. Clients may be counted under more than one type of service.



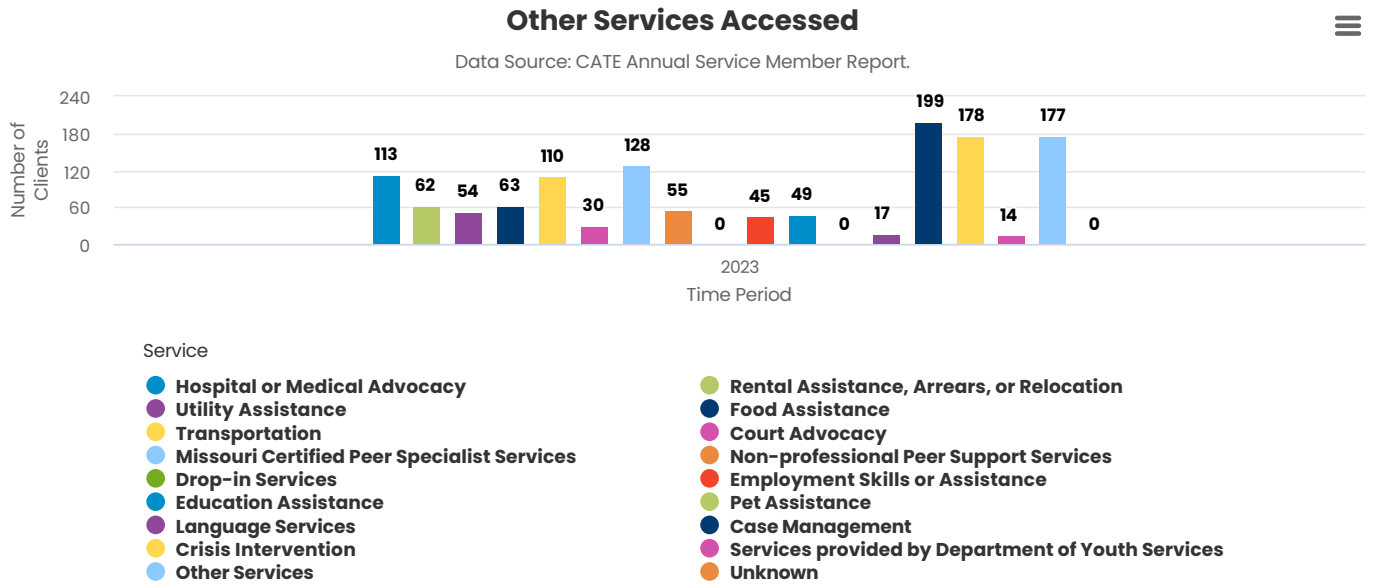
Residential Services Accessed

Other Services Accessed

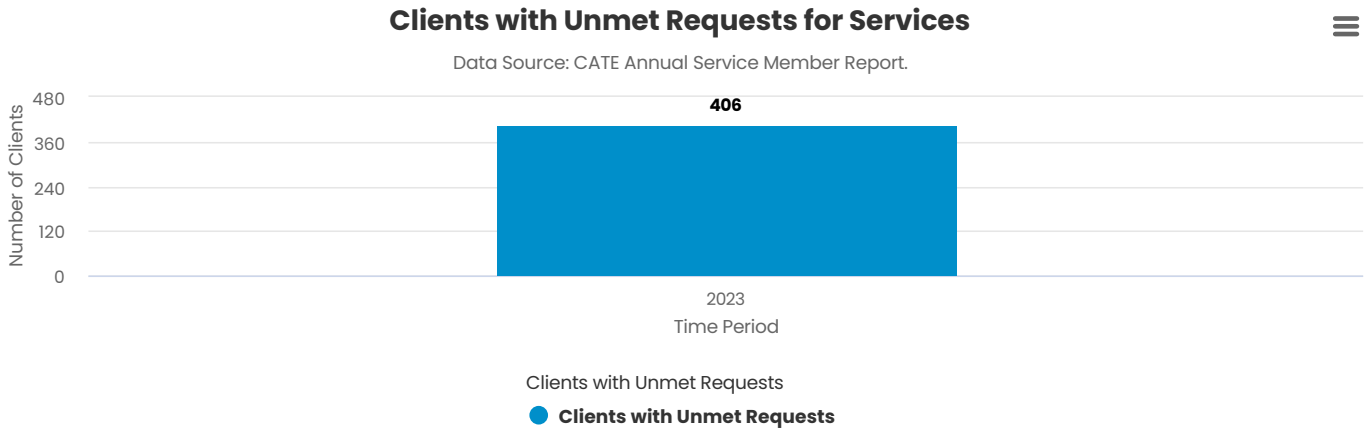
This represents the number of clients accessing each service. Clients may be counted under more than one service.



Unmet Requests for Services

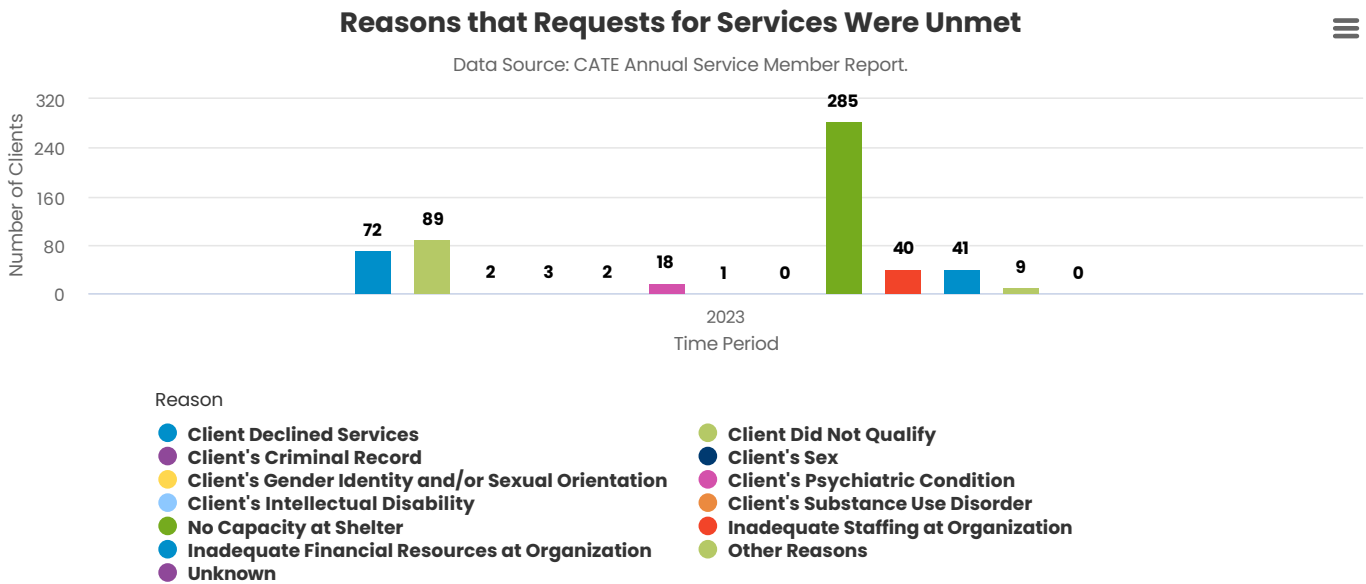
Clients with Unmet Requests for Services

For clients who requested but did not receive services, this represents the number of clients by service denial reason.



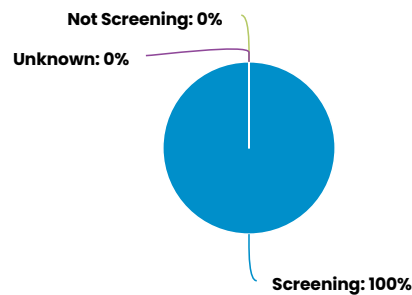
Reporting Organizations

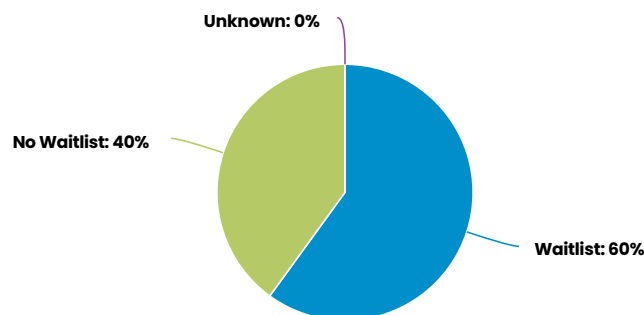


Organizations with a Waitlist for Services
